



# CLASS OF 2021, WHAT MAKES YOU TICK? SURVEY RESULTS





## Q3 Which of the following best describes your gender?



### Q4 Which of the following best represents your racial or ethnic heritage?






### Q5 What best describes your political affiliation?

### Q6 Did you vote in the last U.S. presidential election (in 2016)?



# Q8 Which of the following best describes your feelings about the Trump Administration?







# Q10 Did you attend graduate school and receive a Masters or PhD before applying to law school?






Q12 Did	you take the	LSAT or GRE?

# Q13 Which of the following reasons best describes why you did NOT consider taking the GRE when applying to law school?






### Q14 Why did you take both the LSAT and GRE?

# Q15 Which of the following best describes why you took only the GRE prior to applying to law school?





# Q16 Which of the following reasons best represents your PRIMARY reason for applying to law school during the most recent admissions cycle?






### Q17 Do you intend to practice law after you graduate from law school?

### Q18 If given a choice, what type of law would you practice?




